Saturday morning, September 24, 2022 has been set for the annual Benton County Safety Day Camp. All 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th graders in Benton and Linn County are welcome to attend.

Pre-registration is required by Tuesday, September 20, 2022 and registration is limited so please return the attached registration/consent form as soon as possible.

The camp will be held at the Benton County Fairgrounds on the south-east corner of Vinton.

Check-in is at 8:30 am and parents may pick up their children at 12:15 pm. The event is being sponsored by Progressive Agriculture, Farm Bureau, Benton County ISU Extension & Outreach, Vinton-Shellsburg, Belle Plaine & Benton Community FFA Chapters, Unity Point Clinic (Vinton & Shellsburg Family Practice), beef, pork, dairy commodity groups, numerous local businesses and individuals.

All children are invited to attend, both farm and non-farm. The highest rate of farm injuries occur in children ages 5 – 14. This year we will feature 10 safety stations. Topics this year include ATV Safety, First Aid, Tractor/Semi Safety, Water Safety, 911 Emergency, Grain Safety, Animal Safety, Electrical Safety, Fire Safety and Skid loader Safety

The camp, snack, lunch, T-SHIRT and an educational materials bag are all provided **FREE of charge** to 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th grade students in Linn & Benton County. Our sponsors, both local and national, will provide the financial support necessary for the Safety Day Camp. Adults are welcome to attend with their child.
