We are privileged to have staff from INVISION Architecture leading these discussions on proposed facility updates and to provide invaluable insights into associated costs and expenditures. The **primary focus of these meetings will be to delve into the necessity for a bond to address several critical projects, requiring input from stakeholders as the district moves forward with potential bond initiatives**.
