Dear CPU Parents and Families:

As we enter the final five weeks of the school year, I wanted to share a few important updates with you:

School Hours, Calendar, and Last Student Day

At the April 17, 2025 Board meeting, I shared that, to date, the district has missed a total of 37.58 hours (equivalent to 5.78 days) due to inclement weather. Even with these weather impacts, CPU remains 22.42 hours (or 3.45 days) above the state-required minimum of 1080 hours.

As a result, the last day of school for students for the 2024-25 school year remains Thursday, May 29, with an early dismissal at 12:45 p.m.

Registration for the 2025-26 School Year

To streamline and enhance the registration process, online registration (OLR) will open on August 1, 2025. (Note: The district is exploring an alternative process for preschool registration.)

The goal is to provide families with a clear, "one-stop-shop" experience for completing:

- Payments
- Annual permissions (e.g., handbooks, medication forms, etc.)
- Student information updates (e.g., address, emergency contacts, health information)
