

CPU Youth Basketball Program Sign-up **2nd through 8th Grade Girls & Boys Basketball**

CPU Youth Basketball Committee is a program designed to focus on the CPU youth basketball development for both boys and girls in our school district grades 2nd - 8th. This organization is outside of the CPU school jurisdiction, but we work with our schools basketball coaches & Athletic Director to build our program accordingly. The program will combine the learning opportunity for grade specific basketball fundamentals.

Each family has the **choice** in how they would like their child to participate this season.

- 1) **Practice only-** This would be practicing with their peers only. No games or traveling. Would still need to get a jersey purchased for practices. Practice will begin the week of October 20th and will end in the middle of December. **Cost-\$10 + jersey fee**
- 2) **Practice and Tri-Rivers games-** This would be everything in option 1 in addition to playing in Tri-Rivers that would happen every Saturday from November 1st -December 20th (holiday weekends would NOT play games). A team(s) would travel to nearby towns and compete in likely 2 games. The towns competing in this are Alburnett, West Delaware, Independence, East Buchanan, Jesup, Vinton Shellsburg, North Linn and CPU as of now. Once this season is complete, there are no other practices. These leagues are designed for the development of a player to learn the game and compete against other teams who are learning the game. These are great experiences for those just diving into playing basketball. Some coaches may look at competing in some School Team only tournaments but that will be at the discretion of the coach (extra cost would be assessed by the coach at that time). This isn't a requirement. **Cost-\$10, jersey fee and local travel expenses**
- 3) **Practice, Tri-Rivers & Travel Team-** This option includes all the above in addition to the following. The season will begin at the end of October and finish early March. Travel teams will play many tournaments (will likely be a mix of local and outside the area), outside leagues that are available in Eastern Iowa (ie. YMCA, Cedar Rapids Club teams, etc). This does require a commitment to the team and the long season. This can cost up to \$150 (+/-) depending on the number of participants. Once you have committed to the team, you will pay fees even if your child can't participate in any given league game or tournament. This allows fees to be manageable for everyone. Coaches will collect costs and communicate prior to the travel season. ***Cost-\$150 (+/-) (this includes \$10 committee fee) + jersey fee**

**Additional travel team expenses could include but not limited to overnight hotel accommodation, food, spectator entry fees, etc.*

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Parent Responsibilities

- **CPU Youth Basketball Program financial fee** – \$10 practice fee will be a part of all grades. Additional fees depending on commitment level chosen
- **Child attends practices** -They will be scheduled as gym time is available and fits coaches schedules; including Saturday & Sunday
- **Required Parents Meeting-** Attend the parents meeting on **October 8th 7:30** at the High School Gym.
- **Support your child-** Provide transportation to and from practices, games and tournaments. Give them encouragement after practices and games. They need your support!
- **Volunteer:** Each team will have needs to help make the experience for the youth enjoyable, meaningful and beneficial for their development. Roles such as a team treasurer, CPU youth basketball tournament concession stand or gate entrance help, team manager (communicate practices, games, register for tournaments, etc), help with practice only, etc. We need parents to help in roles. Everyone is volunteering their time to help make our youths' basketball experience the best it can be.
- **Respond to emails or team communications:** When asked to respond please do this in a timely fashion for the coach or communication lead. Most of the communication will be through email or a team specific apps (ie. Game Changer or Team Snap)
- **Respect-** the coaches, volunteers, CPU Youth Basketball committee and referees! You, your family and the people who come to cheer on your child are representing your child, their team, their school & community. Actions matter and reflect on everyone involved.
